



A renewed European strategy for Pharmaceuticals in Europe

A review and discussion of the European Commission 10 December 2008 package comprising:

- Communication to launch reflections on ways to improve market access and to develop initiatives to boost EU pharmaceutical research.
- Proposal to tackle the growing issues of Counterfeiting and illegal distribution of medicines.
- Proposals to enable citizens to have access to high-quality information on prescription-only medicines
- Proposals to improve patient protection by strengthening the EU system for the safety monitoring ('pharmacovigilance') of medicines.

This meeting provides a unique opportunity, early in the legislation process, to gain an understanding of what is proposed in the Pharma Package, and to hear from the Commission, from those it will affect and from critical observers. It will help you to form your own views on what is to be welcomed and what might be improved. This will be an essential meeting for everyone who has an interest in future legislation on 'Information for Patients', "Counterfeit medicines" and "Pharmacovigilance".

The proposals have already proved controversial and there is likely to be much more debate over coming months. That debate should be based on an informed understanding of the proposals.

- Want to be a successful player in a competitive industry that generates safe, innovative and accessible medicines or
