FEES REGULATIONS

2022/23



Fees for the TOPRA MSc in Regulatory Affairs are split into three separate categories, as follows:

Category One: Enrolment Fee

Upon enrolment to become a registered student you are liable for a single, one-off charge of UK £2060.00 (plus V.A.T. at 20%) from September 2022 – this is non-refundable and covers your registration both with TOPRA and with the University of Hertfordshire.

Category Two: Annual Registration Fee

At the beginning of each academic year (1st September) you must pay the annual registration fee in force at that time. This charge is currently UK £850.00 for TOPRA members and £1100.00 for non-members (plus V.A.T. at 20%).

Please note the following in relation to the annual registration fee:

- (i) this fee will be collected by the annual registration process;
- (ii) **all** students who matriculate before the 1st September in any calendar year are liable to pay the annual registration fee on 1st September that year;
- (iii) **every** registered student is liable to pay the annual registration fee on 1st September for each academic year they are registered, up until the date that they submit their MSc dissertation;
- (iv) **no** student will be permitted to attend modules as a registered student or receive other tuition or support during an academic year until the annual registration fee is paid.

Category Three: Postgraduate Module Fees

All students are liable to pay the advertised charge for each module they attend. This charge is in addition to the one-off matriculation fee and the ongoing annual registration fee and is payable at the time of booking on to a module. Currently £1500.00 (plus V.A.T. at 20%).

Category Four: Dissertation Module Fee

From September 2022 this will be £1050.00 (plus V.A.T. at 20%).
